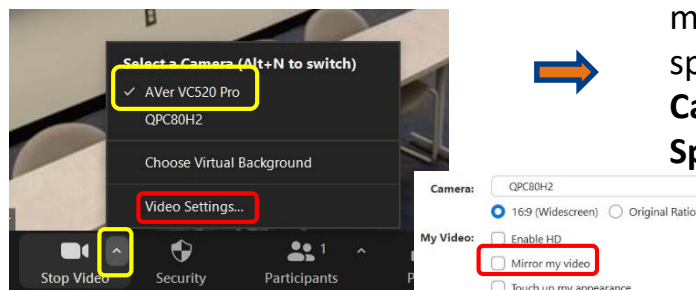


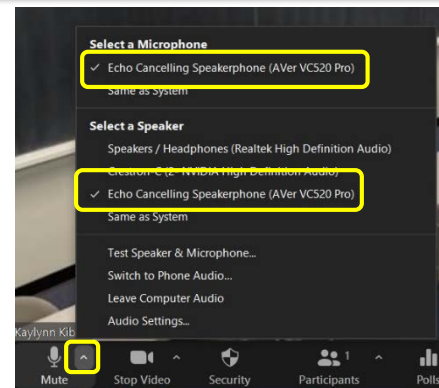
Using the classroom camera with Zoom

1. Select the **AVer camera** (Aver VCS520 Pro), to show your Zoom audience the classroom.

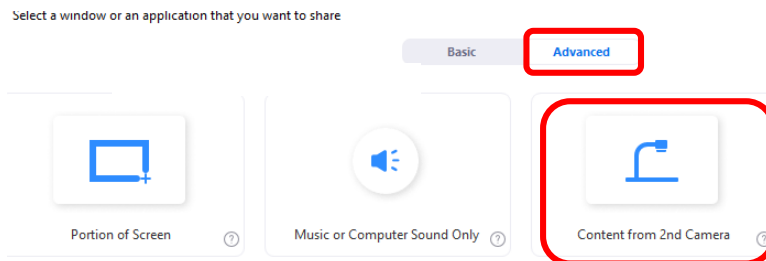
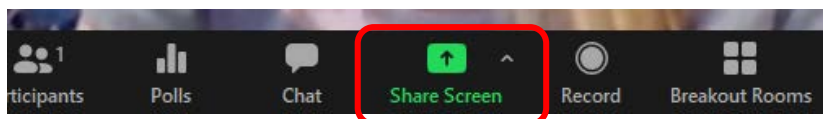
If your image is backwards, click video settings and uncheck, “mirror my video.”



2. If not already selected, set microphone and speaker to “**Echo Cancelling Speakerphone**.”



3. To share the document camera with your Zoom audience, click **Share Screen** in Zoom, and then select **Advance**. From here, select “**Content from second camera**.”



4. To control the camera on the wall, you will use the remote.

Use the arrows to manually move the camera around the room to your desired viewpoint.

OR

Select one of the preset numbers and the camera will move to show a pre-set location (instructor cart, chalkboard, students, etc.).



To use presets:
Press **green P button** (do NOT hold), then press your **preset number**.

1. Instructor cart
2. Front of room
3. Students
4. Whiteboard / chalkboard (if applicable)

To create new preset:
Hold down the green P button, then press preset number
